CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ending July 12, as reported by the Federal reserve banks, was \$2,230,000,000, an increase of \$5,000,000 compared with the preceding week and a decrease of \$187,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1932.

On July 12 total reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,201,000,000, a decrease of \$5,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with a decrease of \$85,000,000 in money in circulation, offset in part by increases of \$50,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$6,000,000 in unexpended capital funds, nonmember deposits, etc., and a decrease of \$25,000,000 in Treasury currency, adjusted.

Bills discounted decreased \$10,000,000 at the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco and \$14,000,000 at all Federal reserve banks. The System's holdings of bills bought in open market declined \$10,000,000, while holdings of Treasury certificates and bills increased \$12,000,000.
