#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended October 17, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,457,000,000, an increase of \$2,000,000 compared with the preceding week and a decrease of \$39,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1933.

On October 17 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,457,000,000, an increase of \$9,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$17,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$10,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, offset in part by increases of \$5,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$7,000,000 in Treasury and National bank currency and a decrease of \$10,000,000 in money in circulation.

There were practically no changes in the System's holdings of bills discounted bills bought in open market and of United States Government securities.
