CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended November 28, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,464,000,000 a decrease of \$13,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$120,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1933.

On November 28 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,460,000,000, a decrease of \$10,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with a decrease of \$88,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and increases of \$36,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$10,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency, offset in part by increases of \$61,000,000 in money in circulation and \$61,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks.

The System's holdings of bills discounted and of industrial advances increased \$1,000,000. each, while holdings of bills bought in open market and of United States Government securities remained practically unchanged.
