CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended March 20, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,461,000,000, a decrease of \$2,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$60,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1934.

On March 20 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,455,000,000, a decrease of \$5,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with increases of \$211,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$12,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and a decrease of \$4,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency offset in part by a decrease of \$227,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and an increase of \$3,000,000 in monetary gold stock.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and of industrial advances. A decrease of \$2,000,000 in holdings of Treasury bills was offset by an increase of \$2,000,000 in United States bonds.
