CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended June 12, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,476,000,000, an increase of \$2,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$32,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1934.

On June 12 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,472,000,000, a decrease of \$3,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$21,000,000 in money in circulation and \$42,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and an increase of \$100,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by increases of \$135,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$19,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and a decrease of \$7,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$41,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bills was offset by a decrease of \$41,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury notes.
