CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended July 3, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks was \$2,475,000,000, a decrease of \$2,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$7,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1934.

On July 3 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,468,000,000, a decrease of \$4,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with a decrease of \$129,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and an increase of \$10,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by increases of \$121,000,000 in money in circulation and \$11,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and a decrease of \$4,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. Increases of \$23,000,000 in holdings of U. S. Treasury notes and \$2,000,000 in U. S. Treasury bills were partially offset by a decrease of \$24,000,000 in United States bonds.
