### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended July 10, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks was \$2,475,000,000, unchanged from the preceding week and \$7,000,000 above the corresponding week in 1934.

On July 10 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,473,000,000, an increase of \$5,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with an increase of \$152,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, offset in part by decreases of \$68,000,000 in money in circulation, \$70,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$5,000,000 in nonmember deposits and Federal Reserve accounts, and an increase of \$4,000,000 in monetary gold stock.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$5,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bills was offset by a decrease of \$5,000,000 in United States Treasury notes.
