CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended July 17, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,478,000,000, an increase of \$3,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$6,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1934,

On July 17 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,472,000,000, practically unchanged from a week ago, decreases of \$128,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, \$21,000,000 in money in circulation, and \$5,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and an increase of \$4,000,000 in monetary gold stock being largely offset by an increase of \$154,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and a decrease of \$2,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency. Member bank reserve balances on July 17 were estimated to be approximately \$2,340,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and in industrial advances. An increase of \$15,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury notes was offset by a decrease of \$15,000,000 in Treasury bills.
