CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended July 31, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,471,000,000, an increase of \$4,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$7,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1934.

On July 31 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,465,000,000, an increase of \$5,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$23,000,000 in money in circulation and \$155,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, offset in part by decreases of \$143,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$13,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and increases of \$8,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$8,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency. Member bank reserve balances on July 31 were estimated to be approximately \$2,510,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and in industrial advances. An increase of \$5,000,000 in holdings of U. S. Treasury notes was offset by a decrease of \$5,000,000 in Treasury bills.
