CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended August 14, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,476,000,000, unchanged from the preceding week and \$10,000,000 above the corresponding week in 1934.

On August 14 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,477,000,000, an increase of \$1,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$139,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$8,000,000 in money in circulation and a decrease of \$40,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency, offset in part by decreases of \$157,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$4,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and an increase of \$26,000,000 in monetary gold stock. Member bank reserve balances on August 14 were estimated to be approximately \$2,670,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and in industrial advances. An increase of \$14,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasurymotes was offset by a decrease of \$14,000,000 in holdings of Treasury bills.
