CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended September 4, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,478,000,000, an increase of \$4,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$8,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1934.

On September 4 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,472,000,000, an increase of \$1,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$77,000,000 in money in circulation and \$63,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and a decrease of \$13,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency, offset in part by an increase of \$12,000,000 in monetary gold stock and decreases of \$118,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$21,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Member bank reserve balances on September 4 were estimated to be approximately \$2,670,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and in industrial advances. An increase of \$5,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury notes was offset by a decrease of \$5,000,000 in holdings of Treasury bills.
