### STATEMENT FOR THE PRESS

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Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System September 19, 1935.

#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended September 18, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,485,000,000, an increase of \$5,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$12,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1934.

On September 18 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,472,000,000, a decrease of \$7,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$252,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$6,000,000 in money in circulation and an increase of \$21,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by increases of \$210,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$60,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Member bank reserve balances on September 18 were estimated to be approximately \$2,560,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$50,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury notes was offset by decreases of \$28,000,000 in United States bonds and \$22,000,000 in Treasury bills.
