#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended September 25, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,477,000,000, a decrease of \$5,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$13,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1934.

On September 25 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,474,000,000, an increase of \$2,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$100,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$18,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and a decrease of \$8,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency, offset in part by an increase of \$57,000,000 in monetary gold stock and decreases of \$6,000,000 in money in circulation and \$61,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks. Member bank reserve balances on September 25 were estimated to be approximately \$2,620,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$4,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bills was offset by a decrease of \$4,000,000 in United States Treasury notes.
