COMDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended October 9, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,480,000,000, unchanged from the preceding week and \$25,000,000 above the corresponding week in 1934.

On October 9 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,478,000,000, an increase of \$8,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$106,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, \$10,000,000 in money in circulation and \$6,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and a decrease of \$3,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency, offset in part by an increase of \$49,000,000 in monetary gold stock and a decrease of \$67,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks. Member bank reserve balances on October 9 were estimated to be approximately \$2,720,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$43,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bills was offset by a decrease of \$43,000,000 in United States Treasury notes.
