#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended October 16, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,489,000,000, an increase of \$9,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$32,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1934.

On October 16 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,496,000,000, an increase of \$18,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with an increase of \$204,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, offset in part by increases of \$121,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$8,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency and decreases of \$2,000,000 in money in circulation, \$54,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$2,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts.

Member bank reserve balances on October 16 were estimated to be approximately \$2,910,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$5,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bills was offset by a decrease of \$5,000,000 in United States Treasury notes.
