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#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank: credit outstanding during the week ended February 5, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,492,000,000, an increase of \$4,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$29,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1935.

On February 5 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,489,000,000, an increase of \$19,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$49,000,000 in money in circulation, \$6,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$24,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and a decrease of \$11,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by a decrease of \$73,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks. Member bank reserve balances on February 5 were estimated to be approximately \$3,090,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

The System's holdings of bills discounted increased \$3,000,000 during the week, while holdings of bills bought in the open market and of industrial advances were practically unchanged. An increase of \$8,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury notes was offset by a decrease of \$8,000,000 in holdings of Treasury bills.
