#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended February 26, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,482,000,000, a decrease of \$22,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$29,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1935.

On February 26 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,475,000,000, a decrease of \$30,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$30,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$5,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and increases of \$3,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$3,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency, offset in part by increases of \$4,000,000 in money in circulation and \$7,000,000 in member bank reserve balances. Member bank reserve balances on February 25 were estimated to be approximately \$3,060,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills, industrial advances and United States Government securities.
