#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended March 14, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,473,000,000, a decrease of \$4,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$19,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1935.

On March 4 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,475,000,000, unchanged from a week ago. Increases of \$73,000,000 in money in circulation and \$13,000,000 in nonmomber deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts were offset by increases of \$4,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$4,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency and decreases of \$26,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$51,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks. Member bank reserve balances on March 4 were estimated to be approximately \$3,040,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$20,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bills was offset by a decrease of \$20,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury notes.
