### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended March 11, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,474,000,000, a decrease of \$4,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$11,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1935.

On March 11 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,473,000,000, a decrease of \$2,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$3,000,000 in money in circulation and \$27,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and an increase of \$3,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by increases of \$11,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$21,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and a decrease of \$3,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency. Member bank reserve balances on March 11 were estimated to be approximately \$3,010,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$5,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bills was offset by a decrease of \$5,000,000 in holdings of Treasury notes.
