CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended April 1, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,483,000,000, a decrease of \$21,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$14,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1935.

On April 1 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,477,000,000, a decrease of \$8,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$53,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$11,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and increases of \$8,000,000 in monetary gold stock and \$2,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency, offset in part by increases of \$47,000,000 in money in circulation and \$18,000,000 in member bank reserve balances. Member bank reserve balances on April 1 were estimated to be approximately \$2,310,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills, industrial advances, and United States Government securities.
