### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended May 27, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,474,000,000, a decrease of \$7,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$1,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1935.

On May 27 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,465,000,060, a decrease of \$4,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$29,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and \$22,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks, and an increase of \$13,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by increases of \$53,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$6,000,000 in money in circulation. Member bank reserve balances on May 27 were estimated to be approximately \$2,900,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$2,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bills was offset by a decrease of \$2,000,000 in holdings of Treasury notes.
