#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended June 10, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,476,000,000, unchanged from the preceding week and the corresponding week in 1935.

On June 10 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,471,000,000, a decrease of \$18,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$16,000,000 in money in circulation, \$36,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and \$20,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks, and an increase of \$71,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by an increase of \$120,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and a decrease of \$4,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency. Member bank reserve balances on June 10 were estimated to be approximately \$2,950,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$5,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury notes was offset by a decrease of \$5,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bills.
