#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended June 17, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks was \$2,485,000,000, an increase of \$9,000,000 compared with the preceding week and a decrease of \$1,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1935.

On June 17 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,480,000,000, an increase of \$9,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$111,000,000 in money in circulation, and \$964,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks, offset in part by decreases of \$939,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, and \$62,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and an increase of \$63,000,000 in monetary gold stock. Member bank reserve balances on June 17 were estimated to be approximately \$2,040,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discounted and purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$50,000,000 in holdings of United States Treasury bonds was offset by decreases of \$47,000,000 in United States Treasury notes and \$3,000,000 in United States Treasury bills.
