CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended July 15, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,478,000,000, an increase of \$4,000,000 compared with the preceding week and the same amount as reported for the corresponding week in 1935.

On July 15 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,478,000,000, an increase of \$6,000,000 for the week. This increase corresponds with increases of \$58,000,000 in member bank reserve balances, \$6,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$2,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other F. R. accounts and a decrease of \$2,000,000 in Treasury and national bank currency, offset in part by a decrease of \$52,000,000 in money in circulation and an increase of \$7,000,000 in monetary gold stock. Member bank reserve balances on July 15 were estimated to be approximately \$2,920,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in holdings of discount/<sup>ed</sup> and purchased bills, industrial advances and United States Government securities.
