#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bant credit outstanding during the week ended January 6, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,451,000,000, a decrease of \$37,000,000 compared with the preceding week and an increase of \$1,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1936.

On January 6 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,464,000,000, a decrease of \$20,000,000 for the week. This decrease corresponds with decreases of \$77,000,000 in money in circulation and \$5,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and an increase of \$20,000,000 in monetary gold stock, offset in part by increases of \$55,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$23,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks. Member bank reserve balances on January 6 were estimated to be approximately \$2,010,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in the System's holdings of bills discounted, purchased bills, industrial advances and United States Government securities.
