#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The daily average volume of Federal Reserve bank credit outstanding during the week ended February 17, as reported by the Federal Reserve banks, was \$2,482,000,000, a decrease of \$3,000,000 compared with the preceding week and of \$22,000,000 compared with the corresponding week in 1936.

On February 17 total Reserve bank credit amounted to \$2,478,000,000, an increase of \$1,000,000 for the week. Decreases of \$9,000,000 in money in circulation, \$3,000,000 in member bank reserve balances and \$13,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and an increase of \$16,000,000 in monetary gold stock, were offset by an increase of \$42,000,000 in Treasury cash and deposits with Federal Reserve banks. Member bank reserve balances on February 17 were estimated to be approximately \$2,190,000,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Relatively small changes were reported in the System's holdings of bills discounted, purchased bills and industrial advances. An increase of \$9,000,000 in holdings of United States bonds was offset by a decrease of \$9,000,000 in United States Treasury notes.
