#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended April 7 member bank reserve balances increased \$45,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from increases of \$35,000,000 in Reserve bank credit and \$18,000,000 in gold stock and a decrease of \$36,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, offset in part by increases of \$22,000,000 in Treasury cash, \$11,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts \$10,000,000 in money in circulation and a decrease of \$3,000,000 in Treasury currency. Excess reserves of member banks on April 7 were estimated to be approximately \$1,440,000,000, an increase of \$40,000,000 for the week. Inactive gold included in the gold stock and in Treasury cash amounted to \$361,000,000 on April 7, an increase of \$13,000,000 for the week.

Principal changes in holdings of bills and securities were increases of \$25,000,000 in United States bonds and \$32,000,000 in United States Treasury bills, and decreases of \$28,000,000 in United States Treasury notes and \$4,000,000 in discounted bills.
