#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended August 11 member bank reserve balances increased \$45,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from a decrease of \$56,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and an increase of \$11,000,000 in Reserve bank credit, offset in part by increases of \$14,000,000 in money in circulation and \$8,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves on August 11 were estimated to be approximately \$740,000,000, an increase of \$40,000,000 for the week. Inactive gold included in the gold stock and in Treasury cash amounted to \$1,265,000,000 on August 11, an increase of \$34,000,000 for the week.
