CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended September 29 member bank reserve balances increased \$56,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$9,000,000 in money in circulation, \$53,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$2,000,000 in Treasury cash other than inactive gold and an increase of \$3,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by an increase of \$7,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and a decrease of \$5,000,000 in Reserve bank credit. Excess reserves of member banks on September 29 were estimated to be approximately \$1,060,000,000, an increase of \$40,000,000 for the week. Inactive gold included in the gold stock and Treasury cash amounted to \$1,203,000,000 on September 29, an increase of \$41,000,000 for the week.
