### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended February 9 member bank reserve balances decreased \$44,000,000. Reductions in member bank reserves arose from increases of \$2,000,000 in Treasury cash other than inactive gold, \$13,000,000 in/deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$50,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, offset in part by an increase of \$4,000,000 in Treasury currency and a decrease of \$17,000,000 in money in circulation. Excess reserves of member banks on February 9 were estimated to be approximately \$1,410,000,000, an increase of \$20,000,000 for the week. Inactive gold included in the gold stock and in Treasury cash amounted to \$1,223,000,000 on February 9, unchanged for the week.

The principal changes in holdings of bills and securities were an increase of \$10,000,000 in United States Treasury bills and decreases of \$8,000,000 in United States Treasury bonds and \$2,000,000 in United States Treasury notes.
