CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended March 16 member bank reserve balances increased \$17,000,000. Additions to member banks reserve arose from decreases of \$6,000,000 in money in circulation, \$12,000,000 in Treasury cash and \$56,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and increases of \$14,000,000 in Reserve bank credit, \$10,000,000 in gold stock and \$2,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by an increase of \$83,000,000 in Treasury deposits with the Federal Reserve banks. Excess reserves of member banks on March 16 were estimated to be approximately \$1,460,000,000, a decrease of \$10,000,000 for the week. Inactive gold included in the gold stock and in Treasury cash amounted to \$1,188,000,000, unchanged for the week. The principal changes in holdings of bills and securities were an increase of \$21,000,000 in United States Treasury bonds and a decrease of \$21,000,000 in United States Treasury notes.
