CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended June 1 member bank reserve balances increased \$29,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from a decrease of \$90,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and increases of \$10,000,000 in Reserve bank credit, \$13,000,000 in gold stock and \$2,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by increases of \$76,000,000 in money in circulation, \$6,000,000 in Treasury cash and \$5,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on June 1 were estimated to be approximately \$2,640,000,000, an increase of \$10,000,000 for the week.
