CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended September 14 member bank reserve balances increased \$156,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$215,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$29,000,000 in money in circulation, and increases of \$184,000,000 in gold stock and \$4,000,000 each in Reserve bank credit and Treasury currency, offset in part by increases of \$180,000,000 in Treasury cash and \$99,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on September 14 were estimated to be approximately \$3,130,000,000, an increase of \$100,000,000 for the week.
