#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended November 23 member bank reserve balances increased \$91,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$70,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, \$4,000,000 in Treasury cash, and increases of \$78,000,000 in gold stock and \$11,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by increases of \$31,000,000 in money in circulation and \$37,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and a decrease of \$3,000,000 in Reserve bank credit. Excess reserves of member banks on November 23 were estimated to be approximately \$3,350,000,000,000, an increase of \$90,000,000 for the week.
