### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended December 21 member bank reserve balances decreased \$562,000,000. Reductions in member bank reserves arose from increases of \$612,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, \$85,000,000 in money in circulation and \$26,000,000 in Treasury cash, offset in part by increases of \$56,000,000 in Reserve bank credit, \$74,000,000 in gold stock and \$4,000,000 in Treasury currency, and a decrease of \$28,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on December 21 were estimated to be approximately \$2,980,000,000, a decrease of \$500,000,000 for the week.

The principal changes in holdings of bills and securities were an increase of \$54,000,000 in United States Treasury bonds and decreases of \$41,000,000 in United States Treasury notes and \$13,000,000 in United States Treasury bills.
