#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended December 28 member bank reserve balances increased \$105,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$84,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, \$31,000,000 in money in circulation and \$11,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and increases of \$54,000,000 in gold stock and \$2,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by a decrease of \$46,000,000 in Reserve bank credit and an increase of \$30,000,000 in Treasury cash. Excess reserves of member banks on December 28 were estimated to be approximately \$3,070,000,000, an increase of \$90,000,000 for the week.

The principal changes in holdings of bills and securities were an increase of \$30,000,000 in United States Treasury notes and a decrease of \$30,000,000 in United States Treasury bills.
