CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended January 11 member bank reserve balances increased \$137,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$123,000,000 in money in circulation, \$13,000,000 in Treasury cash and \$18,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and increases of \$12,000,000 in gold stock and \$5,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by an increase of \$23,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and a decrease of \$12,000,000 in Reserve bank credit. Excess reserves of member banks on January 11 were estimated to be approximately \$3,440,000,000, an increase of \$140,000,000 for the week.

Principal changes in holdings of bills and securities were an increase of \$23,000,000 in United States Treasury notes and a decrease of \$23,000,000 in United States Treasury bills.
