CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended February 15 member bank reserve balances decreased \$311,000,000. Reductions in member bank reserves arose from increases of \$22,000,000 in money in circulation, \$319,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, \$11,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and \$3,000,000 in Treasury cash, offset in part by increases of \$40,000,000 in gold stock and \$3,000,000 in Reserve bank credit. Excess reserves of member banks on February 15 were estimated to be approximately \$3,170,000,000, a decrease of \$290,000,000 for the week.

The principal changes in holdings of bills and securities were an increase of \$5,000,000 in United States Treasury notes and a corresponding decrease in United States Treasury bills.
