#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended March 15 member bank reserve balances increased \$92,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$43,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$4,000,000 in Treasury cash, and increases of \$30,000,000 in Reserve bank credit, \$60,000,000 in gold stock, and \$3,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by an increase of \$48,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on March 15 were estimated to be approximately \$3,440,000,000, an increase of \$30,000,000 for the week.

The principal changes in holdings of bills and securities were an increase of \$70,000,000 in United States Treasury bonds and a corresponding decrease in United States Treasury notes.
