### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended April 5 member bank reserve balances increased \$193,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from increases of \$132,000,000 in gold stock and \$6,000,000 in Reserve bank credit and decreases of \$98,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, \$10,000,000 in Treasury cash and \$35,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, offset in part by an increase of \$90,000,000 in money in circulation. Excess reserves of member banks on April 5 were estimated to be approximately \$3,710,000,000, an increase of \$190,000,000 for the week.
