#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended April 19 member bank reserve balances increased \$215,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$64,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$6,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and increases of \$175,000,000 in gold stock, \$7,000,000 in Reserve bank credit and \$2,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by increases of \$23,000,000 in money in circulation and \$16,000,000 in Treasury cash. Excess reserves of member banks on April 19 were estimated to be approximately \$4,000,000,000, an increase of \$120,000,000 for the week.
