#### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended April 26 member bank reserve balances increased \$160,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$30,000,000 in Treasury cash and \$38,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and increases of \$109,000,000 in gold stock and \$5,000,000 in Treasury currency, offsct in part by a decrease of \$11,000,000 in Reserve bank credit and increases of \$7,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and \$2,000,000 in money in circulation. Excess reserves of nember banks on April 26 were estimated to be approximately \$4,120,000,000, an increase of \$120,000,000 for the week.
