### CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended June 21 member bank reserve balances decreased \$2,000,000. Reductions in member bank reserves arose from increases of \$13,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$10,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and a decrease of \$21,000,000 in Reserve bank credit, offset in part by increases of \$33,000,000 in gold stock and \$5,000,000 in Treasury currency, and a decrease of \$4,000,000 in Treasury cash. Excess reserves of member banks on June 21 were estimated to be approximately \$4,230,000,000, a decrease of \$30,000,000 for the week.
