CONDITION OF FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended September 6 member bank reserve balances increased \$1.90,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from increases of \$1.95,000,000 in Reserve bank credit, \$88,000,000 in gold stock and \$3,000,000 in Treasury currency, and decreases of \$63,000,000 in Treasury cash and \$33,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, offset in part by increases of \$120,000,000 in money in circulation and \$72,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on September 6 were estimated to be approximately \$4,970,000,000, an increase of \$170,000,000 for the week.

The principal change in holdings of bills and securities was an increase of \$168,000,000 in United States Government securities, direct and guaranteed, of which \$109,000,000 was in bonds and \$59,000,000 in notes.
