#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended December 27 member bank reserve balances increased \$115,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$48,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, \$15,000,000 in money in circulation, and \$85,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and increases of \$44,000,000 in gold stock, \$40,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by a decrease of \$77,000,000 in Reserve bank credit and an increase of \$6,000,000 in Treasury cash. Excess reserves of member banks on December 27 were estimated to be approximately \$5,050,000,000, an increase of \$150,000,000 for the week.

The principal change in holdings of bills and securities was a net decrease of \$7,000,000 in United States Government securities, direct and guaranteed; holdings of bonds increased \$93,000,000 and holdings of notes decreased \$100,000,000.
