#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended January 10 member bank reserve balances increased \$109,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$118,000,000 in money in circulation and \$26,000,000 in Treasury cash, and increases of \$50,000,000 in gold stock and \$2,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by a decrease of \$60,000,000 in Reserve bank credit and increases of \$4,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks and \$23,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on January 10 were estimated to be approximately \$5,380,000,000, an increase of \$110,000,000 for the week.

Holdings of United States Government bonds, direct and guaranteed, declined \$7,000,000 for the week.
