#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended January 31 member bank reserve balances increased \$2,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from a decrease of \$23,000,000 in Treasury cash and increases of \$52,000,000 in gold stock and \$2,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by increases of \$42,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, \$9,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and \$11,000,000 in money in circulation and by a decrease of \$11,000,000 in Reserve bank credit. Excess reserves of member banks on January 31 were estimated to be approximately \$5,560,000,000, a decrease of \$30,000,000 for the week.
