#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended March 27 member bank reserve balances increased \$38,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$13,000,000 in money in circulation and \$7,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve banks, and an increase of \$53,000,000 in gold stock, offset in part by a decrease of \$10,000,000 in Reserve bank credit and increases of \$6,000,000 in Treasury cash and \$17,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on March 27 were estimated to be approximately \$5,680,000,000, an increase of \$90,000,000 for the week.
