#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended September 4 member bank reserve balances increased \$8,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from a decrease of \$22,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and increases of \$73,000,000 in gold stock, \$10,000,000 in Reserve Bank credit, and \$2,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by increases of \$86,000,000 in money in circulation and \$12,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on September 4 were estimated to be approximately \$6,490,000,000, unchanged for the week. The item "Foreign bank" deposits has been changed to "Foreign" deposits as the item now includes deposits of some foreign governments for whom the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, as fiscal agent of the United States, has opened accounts.

The principal change in holdings of bills and securities was a decrease of \$3,000,000 in United States Government securities, direct and guaranteed; holdings of bands decreased \$1,000,000 and of notes \$7,000,000.
