#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended November 13 member bank reserve balances increased \$73,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$10,000,000 in Treasury cash and \$61,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and increases of \$56,000,000 in gold stock and \$2,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by a decrease of \$36,000,000 in Reserve Bank credit and increases of \$10,000,000 in money in circulation and \$11,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on November 13 were estimated to be approximately \$6,800,000,000, an increase of \$70,000,000 for the week.

The principal change in holdings of bills and securities was a reduction of \$73,000,000 in United States Government securities, direct and guaranteed: holdings of bonds decreased \$48,000,000 and of notes \$25,000,000.
